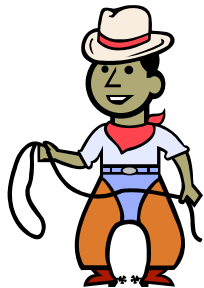

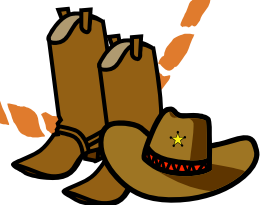

## WHAT INFORMATION IS NEEDED TO ENROLL MY CHILD?

*All applications must be completed at the school.  
All of the documents listed below are required for the application process to be completed.*

### PreKindergarten:

- 2 Proofs of Residency
- Proof of Income
- Child's Birth Certificate
- Immunization Records
- Social Security Card
- Parent Identification

*\* The City of Baker School Board Policy requires that children entering prekindergarten be at least four (4) years of age on or before September 30<sup>th</sup> of the calendar year in which the school year begins.*

### Kindergarten:

- 2 Proofs of Residency
- Proof of Income
- Child's Birth Certificate
- Immunization Records
- Social Security Card
- Parent Identification

*\* The City of Baker School Board Policy requires that children entering kindergarten be at least five (5) years of age on or before September 30<sup>th</sup> of the calendar year in which the school year begins.*



## What Immunizations Are Required?

Children intending to enroll in prekindergarten or kindergarten shall submit a Louisiana Department of Health Certificate of Immunization upon registration. All students are required by the Louisiana Department of Public Health to have the following immunizations:

- Polio** At least 3 doses. At least one dose must have been received after the child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- Hepatitis B** At least 3 doses.
- DPT/DTap** At least 4 doses. At least one dose must have been received after the child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- MR/MMR** 2 doses of measles and rubella. 1 dose of vaccine given on or after 12 months of age. A 2<sup>nd</sup> dose must be given before entering kindergarten.
- Varivax** If a child was born on or after Sept. 15, 1997, to be eligible to start kindergarten, they must have received the varicella vaccine or provide proof that they child has had chicken pox. Immunization must be given on or after 12 months of age.
