



CITY OF BAKER SCHOOL BOARD MEETING October 14, 2014

MINUTES

The City of Baker School Board met in the Board Room of the City of Baker School Board Office beginning at 6:10 p.m. on October 14, 2014. Dr. Carpenter, Board President, called the meeting to order.
