

## City of Baker School Board Special Meeting September 19, 2017

## **MINUTES**

The City of Baker School Board met in special session in the Board Room of the City of Baker School Board Office beginning at 9:00 a.m. on September 19, 2017.

Mrs. Rosatina Johnson, Board President, called the meeting to order.
