

City of Baker School Board Special Meeting June 28, 2017

MINUTES

The City of Baker School Board met in special session in the Board Room of the City of Baker School Board Office beginning at 5:00 p.m. on June 28, 2017.

Mrs. Rosatina Johnson, Board President, called the meeting to order.

A roll call was taken by Mrs. Johnson:

On motion of Mrs. Davis seconded by Mrs. Boxie, the Board voted to approve a lease with Covenant Financial Services, Inc. to lease 1,100 Chromebooks from CDI with a \$1.00 residual at the end of the lease agreement. Voting yes: Johnson, Carpenter, Boxie, Davis and Dees. Voting no: None.

Board Attorney Winston DeCuir, Sr. introduced Ms. Leona Latchie, a Southern University Law School intern, and explained that she would be working at the School Board Office this summer. She will be going through all of the boxes of legal files from the school district's inception and cataloguing them for easy reference.
