On motion of Mrs. Davis seconded by Mrs. Johnson, the Board voted to approve the contract with STEM NOLA to provide educational consulting services and professional development in the areas of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). Superintendent Brister made the following announcements/remarks:

- 1. On December 15<sup>th</sup> there will be a 1 to 1 Parent Tech Night at Baker Middle School at 6:00 p.m. The purpose of the 1 to 1 Parent Tech Night is to educate parents on where we are moving with technology, the meaning of 1 to 1, how to access students' content on the chrome books, how to follow-up on homework given by teachers and how education is becoming more and more paperless. This event will also allow parents to understand how to keep up with their children in regards to technology.
- 2. The District's website is become more and more tech savvy. We are adding links on the website for parents to login to interventions and the core contents and homework.

- 3. The first basketball game of the season was held at Baker Middle School. We have won two basketball games. Varsity basketball team won in Phoenix and the girls' basketball team is improving as well
- 4. The Symphony of Soul won first place at the Organize Chaos at Southern University.
- 5. 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Career Day will be held Wednesday, December 7, 2016, at Baker Middle School.
- 6. Enrollment is up over 20 plus students.
